* 5 Weeks: Monday, June 21st – Friday, July 23rd

* 4 tutoring sessions: (9:00 - 9:50; 10:00 - 10:50; 10:50 - 11:40; 12:10 - 1:00*)

*the fourth tutoring session is different than last year

* Three students a session

* Skills to be covered: Reading, Math and Written Language

*Your responsibilities would include:

-gathering initial assessment information on your students

-designing and implementing lessons for your students in the areas mentioned above

- weekly submissions of lessons plans to your supervisor

-writing a short (2 page) report on the strengths and needs of each student and the progress which he or she made over the five weeks

* There will be a staff member supervising the tutors. She will act as a resource for you and will also be able to provide some teaching materials.

* You will need to complete an application and obtain fingerprint clearance for background check purposes. The process takes several weeks; please be sure to begin the process as soon as you have received confirmation that you will be working at The Lab School this summer. If you are a current LSW faculty member or tutor, you do not have to repeat this process.

* The pay will begin at \$500.00 per class

* Applications are due by **March 1, 2010**

* You will be notified by the end of March
